GUIDELINES GENERAL

All competitors agree to abide by the RHAA rules. It is the responsibility of the competitor to understand the RHAA rules and conditions prior to entering. Only RHAA financial members will be eligible for RHAA EOY Hi Points.

GUIDELINES ATTIRE:

WESTERN ATTIRE MANDATORY; (All divisions) ¬ long sleeved, collared button up shirt. ¬ western hat (the hat must be on the rider's head when the exhibitor enters the arena) or ASS approved safety helmet. ¬ western pants/jeans ¬ western boots. Optional Attire – Necktie, scarf, Spurs, chinks and chaps in ridden classes

GUIDELINES GEAR

No horse under 3 years of age may be exhibited under saddle, No hoof polish/black. No braided or banded manes/tails or tail extensions, Trimming inside ears is discouraged, Trimming bridle path is allowed, also trimming of ¬fetlocks or excessive (long) facial hair, Equipment with silver should not count over a good working outfit, Silver on bridles and ¬ saddles is discouraged, Holding the saddle horn with either hand will not be penalised in any class. Posting or standing in stirrups at extended trot is acceptable. When exhibiting in a snaffle bit or hackamore, an exhibitor may switch between two hands and one hand on the reins at any time.

CROSS ENTERING DIVISIONS:

<u>GREEN RIDER</u> - Walk/trot only. Horse/Rider combination ineligible to cross enter OPEN classes.

GREEN HORSE (snaffle bit & hackamore only)
Horse with minimal show experience.
Professional or nonprofessional riders
HERITAGE SNAFFLE BIT – Ineligible to cross enter
ALL AGE, may cross enter Amateur/ Youth
classes.

OPEN CLASSES: Junior & Senior Horse, Amateur, Select, Masters and All Age; *must be ridden in the correct head gear in a western saddle per RHAA/AQHA rules *Junior horse: Horses five-years-old (5) and younger *Senior Horse: Horses six-years (6) and older

HERITAGE SNAFFLE BIT

Must be ridden in stock, fender or half breed saddle.... No western saddles

YOUTH RIDERS

..... 7 to 18 years as at 1st August.

.....Riders will be required to show their horses at the walk, trot & lope.

..... Youth competitors are to wear an approved safety helmet whilst mounted.

.....Youth must not ride or handle a stallion at any time

INTERMEDIATE Rider – A class for non professional adult riders with some previous show experience,

Professional riders are NOT eligible for this class. Riders will be required to show their horses at the walk, trot & lope. Riders can ride in a snaffle, hackamore or a curb bit with split reins or a romal.

Any 'safe' saddle, with the exclusion of bareback pads. Includes; English, Western, stock, fender or half breed saddles.

INTERMEDIATE HORSE – Open to all riders – professional and nonprofessional. Horses with previous show experience may be shown in this class.

Horses will be required to show at the walk, trot & lope.

Any 'safe' saddle, with the exclusion of bareback pads. Includes; English, Western, stock, fender or half breed saddles.

GREEN HORSE

Open to all riders – professional and nonprofessional – wanting to bring inexperienced horses (3 Yr and over) into the show arena.

.....Horses will be required to show at the walk, trot & lope.

Any 'safe' saddle, with the exclusion of bareback pads. Includes; English, Western, stock, fender or half breed saddles.

GREEN RIDER

A class for inexperienced adult riders, open riders are NOT eligible for this class.

....Riders will be required to show their horses at the walk & trot only. The purpose of this class is to encourage those new to riding and/or new to showing.

Those entered in this class are Ineligible for any Intermediate or Open classes.

Any 'safe' saddle, with the exclusion of bareback pads. Includes; English, Western, stock, fender or half breed saddles.

GREEN YOUTH

.....A class for inexperienced Youth riders. Open to Youth up to 18 years as at 1st August.

.....Riders will be required to show their horses at the walk & trot only.

.....Must have written permission from their parent/guardian to compete. Parent/guardian must sign the entry form.

.....All Youth competing or taking part in an RHAA sanctioned event must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the

duration of that event, whilst the Youth attends that event.

.....The purpose of this class is to encourage Youth who are new to riding and/or new to showing in Ranch events

AMATEUR

Person must be a financial member of the association and hold either an individual Full, Life or Honorary Life membership in their own name;

The amateur must agree as follows; Have not, in the previous three (3) years received remuneration or compensation for: Showing or training any horse or instructed any other person in riding, driving or exhibiting;

Payment by another person for stable and or yard fees, bedding or camping fees will not be considered remuneration if the Amateur reimburses the payee;

Prize money or judging fees will not be considered as remuneration;

Amateurs may accept Sponsorship in the form of goods only.

Exception would be Amateurs fundraising for a sanctioned RHAA event.

RANCH PROSPECT

....Horse competing in Led Ranch Prospect Classes may not be shown under saddle at the same show. Horses competing under saddle may not compete in any Led Ranch Prospect classes at the same show.

WHO CAN COMPETE?

All breeds are permitted at any RHAA event and horses are not required to be registered to any breed society.

Unregistered horses must have a proof of age certificate supplied by a veterinarian to enter Amateur, Select Amateur, Youth or Open All Aged events inc Senior horse or Junior Horse.

Rules and Regulations:

- All Competitors/ participants are to uphold these rules and regulations at all times.
- Competitors/ participants at any event run by CCWRC have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and to treat their horses humanely with respect, dignity and compassion at all times.
- Competitors/ participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with CCWRC, JUDGES, STEWARDS, VOLUNTEERS and other competitors at all times.
- NO ALCOHOL is allowed in, or can be consumed in the marshalling areas, working arenas or show pen/ contest areas.
- The show is being held under RHAA ules.
- On the day of the show, from 1 hour prior to the commencement of the show until 1 hour after the cessation of the show, there will be no training equipment allowed in the immediate marshalling area and the performance arena.
- worn when in the show or marshalling arena
- Exhibitors must not approach the Judge for any reason prior to completion of the

- judging. unless the exhibitor has finished exhibiting and the request must be made through the Ring Steward.
- No exhibitor will request information from the Judge, or the decisions made by that Judge, concerning any exhibit at the show, on the day or the show or with the immediate 7days following the show.
- Marshalling area is strictly for competitors and strappers only.
 Assistants/ strappers must be a financial member of the club.
- Once show is in progress competitors only allowed in arena, excepting stewards, judge and medical personnel.
- Show Management reserve the right to alter the order of events before/ during show.
- Pre-entries are required. Closing date is ..17/04/2025... Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied full payment and all registration and membership numbers.
- NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN unless notification of withdrawal is accompanied by a veterinary or medical certificate.
- All persons enter the show and grounds at their own risk.
- Show Management and property owner will take no responsibility for loss or

- damage of stock, equipment or person property.
- All dogs must be restrained/on leashes at all times. NO dogs allowing in marshalling area or arena.
- All youth competing or taking part in event, must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant.
- All youth competing or taking part in CCWRC approved event, must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of the event.
- Youth must be 18 years of age or under as of August 1st 2024.
- Youth are not permitted to ride or handle Stallions or Colts in any event.
- Riders in pre-Youth events are not eligible to compete in any other ridden class.
- Wearing of approved safety helmets is mandatory. These are non-point scoring classes.
- Identification:
- All registration papers and membership cards must be presented at the request of show management. Horses competing in Led Versatility are not eligible to compete in ridden events.
- Numbers must be clearly displayed to be eligible to compete.
