# ALL BREEDS, REGISTERED OR UNREGISTERED ARE WELCOME

- No horse under 3 years of age may be exhibited:
- ➤ No hoof polish/black;
- No braided or banded manes/tails or tail extensions;
- Trimming inside ears is discouraged.
- Trimming bridle path is allowed, along with trimming of fetlocks or excessive (long) facial hair;
- Equipment with silver does not count over a good working outfit. Silver on bridles and saddles is discouraged;
- ➤ Holding the saddle horn with either hand will not be penalised in any class;
- Posting or standing in stirrups at extended trot is acceptable;

It is up to individual competitors in the green & intermediate classes to familiarise themselves with the RHAA rules prior to entries. If you are not sure, please direct any questions via email prior to the organiser.

## LEVEL 1 – GREEN:

- Any age horse may be ridden two handed in a *Snaffle Bit or hackamore.* (No curb/shank bits)
- Any 'safe' saddle, with the exclusion of bareback pads. Includes; English, Western, stock, fender or half breed saddles.
- ➤ Ownership of horse not required a borrowed horse may be used

Green Rider – A class for inexperienced adult riders, open riders are NOT eligible for this class. Riders will be required to show their horses at the walk & trot only. The purpose of this class is to encourage those new to riding and/or new to showing in Ranch events. Those entered in this class are Ineligible for INTERMEDIATE or OPEN classes.

**Green Horse**. Open to all riders – professional and nonprofessional – wanting to bring inexperienced or young horses (3 Yr and over) into the show arena. Horses will be required to show at the walk, trot &

lope. This class is aimed at giving green horses of all ages an opportunity to attain show experience.

Green Youth – A class for inexperienced Youth riders. Open to Youth up to 18 years as at 1st August. Riders will be required to show their horses at the walk & trot only. Must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event. In the case of a Show the parent/guardian must also sign the entry form. All Youth competing or taking part in an RHAA sanctioned event must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the Youth attends that event. The purpose of this class is to encourage Youth who are new to riding and/or new to showing in Ranch events

#### LEVEL 2 - INTERMEDIATE

- ➤ Horse may be ridden one or two handed in any legal headgear (see RHAA rules 'Gear)
- ➤ Rider must not swap from one to two hands or visa versa during the class
- Any safe saddle, with the exception of bareback pads. Includes; English, Western, stock, fender or half breed saddles permitted

Intermediate Rider – A class for nonprofessional adult riders with some previous show experience, professional riders are NOT eligible for this class. Riders will be required to show their horses at the walk, trot & lope. Riders can ride in a snaffle, hackamore or a curb bit with split reins or a romal.

Intermediate Horse – Open to all riders – professional and nonprofessional. Horses with previous show experience may be shown in this class. Horses will be required to show at the walk, trot & lope.

Intermediate Youth – A class for Youth riders with some previous show experience. Open to Youth riders, 7 to 18 years as at 1st August. If one (1) class is held to be: 7 to 18 years old if two (2) classes held: 7 to 13 years and 14 to 18 years. Riders will be required to show their horses at the walk, trot & lope.

## Levels 3 (Heritage Snaffle Bit) and Level 4 Run under the AQHA rules

- ➤ Western saddles mandatory (Heritage snafflebit division excluded)
- ➤ Horses to be ridden in head gear according to its age per the AQHA rule book
- Rider must own (or lease) the horse they are riding

Heritage Snaffle Bit class. Open to horses 3 years and over. Ridden two handed in a Snaffle Bit regardless of horses age. Equipment: Fender, stock or half-breed saddle. (NO western saddles permitted) Riders are ineligible to compete in any other AQHA classes at the same show. (Junior/Senior Horse, Amateur, Select Amateur)







# **JUDGES PENNY WEBB & STEVE THAKE**

**OPEN**. Junior & Senior horses eligible.

**Junior Horse**. Horses 3-5Yo, regardless of rider level. Can be ridden in a Snaffle Bit, hackamore, or curb bit one handed.

Senior Horse. Open to all horses and riders, regardless of rider level (includes amateur and select amateur) Horses MUST be ridden one handed in a bridle, split reins and romal permitted.

**Amateur:** For those members of the Association, who are no longer eligible to exhibit in Youth classes, who are not professionals in the horse industry and who ride their horses for the pleasure of competing against other members who are also not professional;

**Select Amateur:** A person who has attained the age of 50 years and provides proof of age, which must be in the form of a copy of a driver's licence or birth certificate, who are not professionals in the horse industry and who ride their horses for the pleasure of competing against other members who are also not professional

Youth – Open to all Youth 7 to 18 years of age. If one (1) class is held to be: 7 to 18 years old if two (2) classes held: 7 to 13 years and 14 to 18 years. Must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event. In the case of a Show the parent/guardian must also sign the

entry form. All Youth competing or taking part in an RHAA sanctioned event must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the Youth attends that event. Youth MUST ride in correct headgear and attire as per AQHA Rules. A Youth can show non-owned horses in Youth classes and Open classes.

## **EQUIPMENT:**

#### **LEVEL 1 GREEN**

- Any age horse may be ridden two handed in a Snaffle Bit or hackamore.
- Any 'safe' saddle, with the exclusion of bareback pads. Includes; English, Western, stock, fender or half breed saddles.

#### **LEVEL 2 INTERMEDIATE:**

- Any legal Snaffle Bit, (see EQUIPMENT in the RHAA rule book) or legal headgear.
- Any 'safe' saddle, with the exclusion of bareback pads. Includes; English, Western, stock, fender or half breed saddles.

### & LEVEL 4 OPEN (\*AQHA RULES)

- Western saddles, with the exception of Level 3 (Heritage Snaffle Bit class) which must be ridden in stock, fender or half breed saddle. All other equipment requirements per the AQHA performance rules.
- ➤ **OPEN** (Junior Horse, Senior Horse as below)
- ➤ Junior horse: 3 to 5 yo. Horse's five-yearsold (5) and younger may be shown in a Snaffle Bit, Hackamore, curb bit, half-breed or spade bit.
- Senior Horse: 6 years and over. Horse's sixyears (6) and older can only be shown in a curb bit, half-breed, romal, spade bit or two rein.

## **ATTIRE:**

# WESTERN ATTIRE MANDATORY; (All divisions)

- long sleeved, collared button up shirt.
- western hat (the hat must be on the rider's head when the exhibitor enters the arena) or ASS approved safety helmet.
- western pants/jeans
- western boots.

**Optional Attire** – Necktie, scarf, Spurs, chinks, and chaps in ridden classes.

Show management may exclude horses from competition should there be any unnecessary delay on the part of the exhibitor in bringing the horse into the competition arena. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to present

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to present themselves at the competition arena gate when called. Failure to report on final call will result in disqualification from the class. In the event that a horse is excluded from entry, all entry fees and charges for the class are forfeited

without liability to the show organizers/committee. Show management reserve the right to change the order of classes before or during the show. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be aware of any changes which will be posted at the Show Secretary's office and announced. Officials will make sure to give one hour's notice of any changes to the running order of events; however, every effort will be made to avoid changes. Any exhibitor or rider who refuses to obey the request of the Judge, Show Manager or any show official will be automatically disqualified from further competition at the show and forfeits all previous winnings together with all entry fees and other charges. At the discretion of the Show Manager or show committee, the offending individual and his/her entire exhibit may be removed from the grounds.

All horses must be serviceably sound. In case of suspected unsoundness, the Judge and/or Show Management may, if he/she so desires have the animal examined by the Show Veterinarian and his decision shall be final.

#### **BACK NUMBERS**

- Back Numbers will be allocated per horse and rider combination and must be displayed when competing NO back number or INCORRECT back number = no placing. Back numbers will be available at the show office in competitor bags.
- For halter classes, back number to be displayed on handlers back. For ridden classes, the back number is to be pinned

on either side of the saddle blanket with the numbers displayed clearly.

#### OFFICIAL PHOTOGRAPHER

An official photographer will be in attendance of the show.

Participants by entering this event are giving permission ☐to BWPC to use any and all images for promotional ☐purposes.

Images will be available to all entrants after the event has concluded and must contact the photographer direct.

☐ Please respect that there is to be NO other professional photographers taking photos during the day (July 8th 2023)unless permission from the official photographer has been sort. \*Professional photographer = one being paid for images.

#### **REFUND POLICY**

If the show is cancelled prior to commencing, a full refund will be given excluding the office fees AND nominate commissions

- ☐ Postponed shows or shows cancelled will require the competitor to contact the show secretary to **determine** when they will receive a refund of entries less Office fee plus 20% of remaining nominations to cover show costs.

#### ATTIRE

As per AQHA rules, one hour prior to the show and one hour after the show, anyone using the marshalling or main arenas are required to be appropriately attired - Cap/Western Hat, long western style pants, safe enclosed footwear and a shirt with sleeves must be worn. See AQHA rule book for class attire. Inappropriately attired individuals will be asked to leave the marshalling area.

## RANCH CLASS INFORMATION - AQHA Rule Book -

- The use of two-rein is only allowed in Ranch Reining,
- ☐ Ranch Cow Work/Limited Cow Work.
- Conformation Horses are not to be shown in cords or lip chains.
- Snaffle Bit Division cannot enter All Age AND Snaffle Bit at the same show.
- Horses are to be ridden in a swinging fender, stock saddle or half breed saddle.

Horses must be ridden two-handed in a snaffle bit, egg-butt or D-bit regardless of the horses age

#### **HELMETS**

RULE 80.4 in AQHA rule book—Approved safety helmets that conform to the current Australian Safety Standards must be worn by all Youth competing in working cow horse, boxing, any AQHA sporting class.

### TRAINING EQUIPMENT

As per AQHA rules, one hour prior to the commencement of the show day and one hour after the show day, there will be NO training equipment allowed in the marshalling or main arenas.

#### HIGH POINT INFORMATION

Aqha High points will be calculated as per AQHA rule 45.

Note that youth and amateur MUST nominate a maximum of TWO horses towards the High Point awards at the show.
