Hi Point Awards Ceremony

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

To enter cattle events, rider/horse combo must be entered in a minimum of one other dry ridden class.

All horses on the grounds must be entered in the show & ridden by a current financial member. Exception being horses used for turnback or herd help

Horses can be entered into a maximum of three (3) divisions in the show.

To be eligible for overall division Hi Point, a horse/rider must show in the conformation class and a minimum of two ridden classes within the same division.

Scratching and refunds;

a) Scratch before closing date without penalty. (entries & levies refunded in full)

b) Scratch after closing date with a copy of vet or doctors certificate for refund in full, less office levy of \$30.00 per horse.

c) Scratch after closing date without a vet or doctors certificate – entries & levies are forfeited.

Youth competitors are to wear an approved safety helmet whilst mounted. Youth must not ride or handle a stallion at any time.
