PQHA is an Affiliate of the Australian Quarter Horse Association and, as such, runs in accordance with their rules. These can be found online at the AQHA website.

This RVS show is ran as a separate show from the AA & AA Performance Show.

GENERAL:

Intermediate: Intermediate Horse Open to all riders – professional and non-professional. Horses with some previous show experience maybe shown in this class. Horses will be required to show at the walk, trot and lope.

Gear & Attire

- Any age horse maybe ridden two handed in a snaffle bit or hackamore, or one or two handed in a curb bit.
- Any 'safe' saddle, with the exclusion of bareback pads. Includes. English, western, stock or fender saddles.

Improver/ Green Rider: A class for inexperienced riders, open riders are NOT eligible for this class.

Riders will be required to show their horses at the walk and trot only. The purpose of this class is to encourage those new to riding and/or new to showing. Those entered in this class are Ineligible for INTERMEDIATE or OPEN classes

Gear & Attire

- Any age horse ridden two handed in a snaffle bit or hackamore only.
- Any 'safe' saddle, with the exclusion of bareback pads. Includes. English, Western, stock, or
- fender saddles
- It is recommended that riders wear a helmet.

Youth/Amateur/Select Amateur: copy of relevant association permit/membership

Attire:

 as per AQHA rule book for recognised categories ie Amateur, Youth, All Age.

Rules & Condition of Entry

PQHA is an Affiliate of the Australian Quarter Horse Association and, as such, runs in accordance with their rules. These can be found online at the AQHA website.

In the case of extreme weather, show cancellation will be called Tuesday morning.

GENERAL:

- Novice Horse/Novice Amateur: Must have less than 20 points in event. May only enter in this event. Copies of permits required.
- **Beginner:** Walk/Jog/Trot May only enter in this event. If using a bridle, horses can be ridden 1 or 2 handed but must not change from 1 hand back to 2 hands (or vice-verse) after entering the show arena. Pqha recommend that riders wear a helmet. Can not have competed at a higher level through out the season or won a Hi Point at any other club.
- Improver: Walk/Jog/Trot/Lope/Canter. May only enter in this event. If using a bridle, horses can be ridden 1 or 2 handed but must not change from 1 hand back to 2 hands (or vice-verse) after entering the show arena. Pqha recommend that riders wear a helmet. Can not have competed at a higher level through out the season or won a Hi Point at any other club.
- Amateur/Select Amateur: copies of permits must be sent with entries.
- Horse Registration: copies must be sent with entries. Horses in Youth, Amateur or All Age must be registered with a society/Association.
- Attire: as per AQHA rule book for recognised categories i.e. Amateur, Youth, All Age.

ENTRY FEES: must be paid at time of entry and any entries received after the closing date will incur \$50 fee. No refunds unless Veterinary or Doctor certificate produced and will incur an administration fee of \$20. Events may be added providing horse/handler combination is already entered. If event is shut down before completion, balance of entry fees, stabling and camping will be repaid less \$20 administration fee.

DISTINGUISHING NUMBERS: Before the commencement of the Show, the **Show Secretary will allocate a number to every entry**. The numbers must be a worn on the handler's back in all Halter classes. Ridden events, numbers are to be placed on both sides of the saddle pads. Failure to wear or to display the correct number in a visible manner will result in disqualification. *Club numbers are not to be used.*

ANIMAL HEALTH: In the case of an outbreak or any contagious or infectious disease amongst horses, neither PQHA nor the sponsors or Tonimbuk Equestrian Centre will be liable for any damages or loss that may occur to any person or animal. The AQHA Statement on Animal Health will apply in all cases to all horses exhibited at this show, including other breeds.

DOGS: MUST be tied or on leash and supervised at all times. It is requested by Tonimbuk Equestrian Centre that dogs are NOT PERMITTED IN THE ARENA AT ANY TIME. The ranger will be called for dogs not complying with this rule and it will be the owners' responsibility and expense to retrieve them from Council's Animal Shelter.

TRAFFIC: Vehicles must be operated within a safe and reasonable speed limit on the show grounds and it is necessary that parking and other traffic regulations be observed.

EXERCISE FACILITIES: At all AQHA approved shows, on each day of the show, 1 hour prior to the commencement of the show and 1 hour after the cessation of the show, there will be no training equipment allowed in the immediate marshalling area and the performance arena. Dress regulations of Cap/Hat, long western style pants, safe enclosed footwear and a shirt with sleeves must be worn in arena.

NO SPECTATORS ARE TO RIDE HORSES for the duration of the show as the AQHA insurance policy doesn't cover or recognise any spectator riding whilst attending an AQHA approved show. No horses to be ridden bareback or two astride.

DRUGS/SURGICAL PROCEDURES: No person shall cause to be administered or used internally or externally to a horse either before or during the show, any medication, drug, device or surgical procedure which is of such a character as could mask a defect. Upon discovery of the administration of such a drug, medication, device or surgical procedure, then the Show Management shall immediately disqualify that horse and report the matter to the AQHA. Swabs shall be taken at the show and prize money may be withheld until the results are returned to the Association. Full details are contained in the Australian Quarter Horse Association Rulebook. All horses are subject to drug testing and all owners agree that by making their entry, they will allow their horses to be drug tested.

OTHER RULES: Any necessary rules and regulations not covered by the current AQHA show and performance rules will be determined by the Show Management and their decision will be final, without recourse of any kind. Show Management reserves the right to add any further applicable rules and regulations before, or during the show. These will be posted on the notice board and will be put over the public address. Such instances could be "Out of bounds working areas, closure of areas to the public or horses," or any other matter that may arise.

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE: All competitors must be either financial members of the AQHA in their own right or PQHA member. Strappers and handlers who are not members of the AQHA or PQHA will be required to pay an event membership of \$20. Proof of current membership is required with entries.

DISPUTES COMMITTEE: The Disputes Committee as per rule 52, shall consist of the Show Manager, One Show Committee Member and One Competitor nominated by the contestants. In the event of more than one competitor is nominated for the position on the Disputes Committee, the Show Manager will conduct a draw for the position.

YOUTH: All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event, must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant and must be in the care of a responsible adult for the duration of that event.

RISK: Competitors and Horses compete at their own risk; the Show Committee will not be responsible for any injury, loss or damage.

PROTESTS: Protest must be made in writing to the Show Secretary and be lodged within 30 minutes of the disputed events finishing. A fee of \$70.00 must accompany each protest lodged.

PRIZE MONIES: Will be paid on a scale of 50%, 30%, 20%. Monies will be paid into bank accounts after close of show. Please note: You are required to forward your banking details at time of entry. Should we not have received your banking details prior to completion of the show, you will automatically forgo your prize money and stable bond.

PHOTOGRAPHY: Please note we may have a club representative taking photos and/or videos that may be released on our club's social media page and/or promotional material. These photos and/or videos are not for personal use. Entering our competition, you automatically grant us permission to use photos and/or video of you and your horse. Should you not wish for this to occur, please advise when you submit your entries.

STABLE/YARD BOND: Will be refunded when stable/yard left clean. Competitors may bring their own bedding (not straw).

AT THE REQUEST OF TONIMBUK EQUESTRIAN CENTRE - NO STRAW IS TO BE USED. ALL MANURE, BEDDING, FEED AND RUBBISH MUST BE PICKED UP FROM STABLES, YARDS AND PARKING AREA.

Manure/bedding/hay to be put in collection points at end of each stable block.

Rubbish into bins please.
